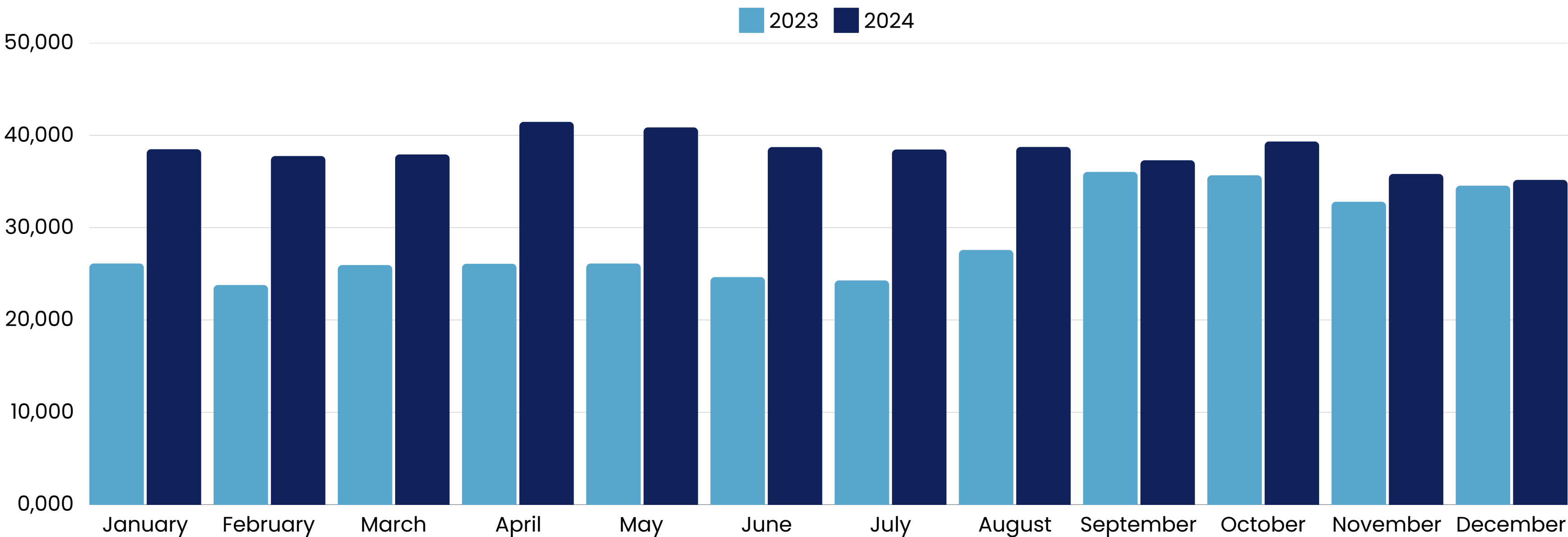


VICTIM SERVICES

RAINN’s victim services programs, including the National Sexual Assault Hotline, responded to more than 460,000 people affected by sexual violence in 2024 and more than 5 million people since our founding in 1994. This is a 34% increase from 2023 and an average of 1,260 calls and chats per day.

RAINN'S POLICY TEAM

RAINN's policy team was hard at work in 2024, championing 129 bills in 32 states along with several key pieces of federal legislation. Our policy team:

- ✓ **Wrote 6 state bills.**
- ✓ **Met with coalitions and partners in 12 states.**
- ✓ **Wrote a model bill for states on the issue of notifying patients of physician misconduct.**

STATE POLICY HIGHLIGHTS

With RAINN's advocacy, 12 states passed 17 bills. Some highlights include:

Ohio HB 161

RAINN was instrumental in advocating for the passage of a law that criminalizes sexual violence within a marriage, allowing married survivors to pursue justice.

Virginia HB 764

RAINN's advocacy will further help survivors escape abusive situations by allowing survivors to terminate housing leases early, preventing them from being financially forced to live with their abusers.

West Virginia SB 190

RAINN was instrumental in advocating for the passage of a law that criminalizes sexual violence within a marriage, allowing married survivors to pursue justice.

Hawaii SB 2439

Due in part to RAINN's advocacy, more survivors will have access to justice with the expansion of the civil statute of limitations. This law will also encourage people to report sexual assault.

FEDERAL POLICY HIGHLIGHTS

RAINN's advocacy led to the passage and advancement of several key federal policies in 2024, including the following.

Debbie Smith Act Reauthorization – Since its initial passage with RAINN's support in 2004, funding from the Debbie Smith Act has resulted in more than 300,000 hits in CODIS, the national DNA database system. With RAINN's advocacy, this bill was reauthorized in July 2024.

PROTECT Act (Preventing Rampant Online Technological Exploitation and Criminal Trafficking Act of 2024) – This bill, which became law in 2024 thanks in part to RAINN's support, prevents the distribution of intimate visual depictions without consent and requires pornographic websites to obtain consent and age and identify verification before allowing posts.

Stop Institutional Child Abuse Act – This is a bill RAINN supported alongside Paris Hilton after she came forward about her experience with child abuse in a troubled teen institution. This bill, signed into law by President Biden, will transform how residential youth programs are run and managed by creating more transparent and accountable systems.

SAFE HELPLINE VISITOR FEEDBACK


RAINN's Safe Helpline provided support for more than 20,000 military members and their families impacted by sexual violence.

- Amazon MGM Studios' *Blink Twice*.



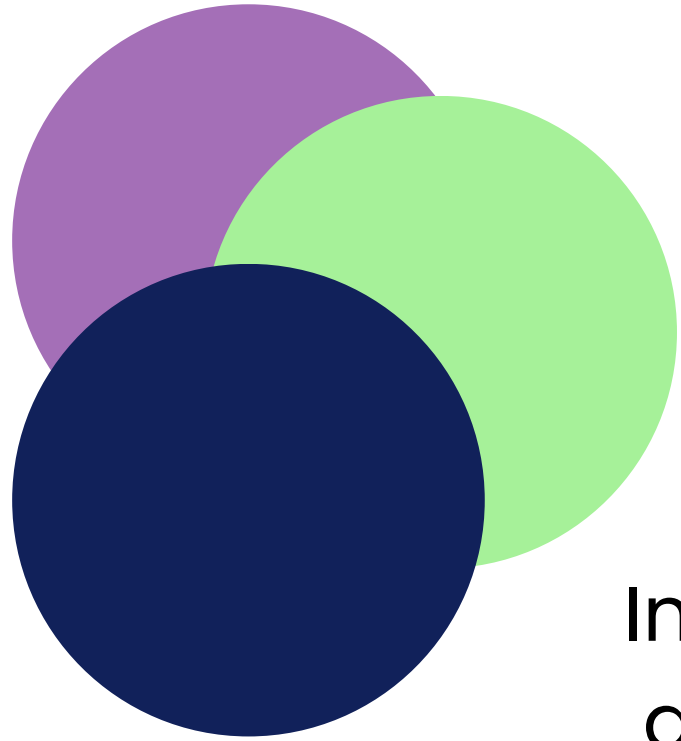


RAINN'S RESEARCH

RAINN's research and evaluation team analyzes anonymous hotline data to enhance the field's understanding of sexual violence and survivors' needs and concerns, monitor trends, and provide data-driven recommendations for the continuous improvement of services.

This year, our research team published two articles, **"*Nothing Was Done*": Experiences of Continued Sexual Abuse After Disclosing to a Mandated Reporter Among Youth in the United States** and **Sexual Abuse and Disclosure Concerns of Youth in Foster Care.**

RAINN's peer-reviewed research critically contributes to the anti-sexual violence community by offering reliable data and analysis and pathways to improved responses for survivors.
